Application Process

- Submission deadline is 28 February 2019.
- Applicants must reside in the Middle East.
- Applicants must be no older than 40 years of age on 28 February 2019.
- A detailed CV including date of birth must be included in the application.
- The applicant must have first or second authorship in the manuscript.
- The paper submitted for review should be a spine related research published paper in an indexed or non-indexed medical journal, (international or regional), from 1 January 2017 until 28 February 2019.
- Applicants can submit only one paper for consideration.
- Applications must consist of a full manuscript in English declaring the background and objectives of the research work, methods, results and conclusions made based on these findings, as well as a balanced discussion of the results in comparison to previous work in the field.
- Applicants are evaluated based on a predefined set of criteria including the relevance of the research question, its clinical impact, and novelty value, the study design, the results and their interpretation.
- The award winners will be selected by the AOSpine Middle East and Northern Africa Research Committee
